

# LEGISLATIVE INQUIRY UPDATE

### PARLIAMENTARY INQUIRY TO BE HELD INTO TASMANIA'S HOSPITAL RESOURCING AND ACUTE HEALTH SERVICES

As members are no doubt aware, in June this year a Legislative Council Government Administration subcommittee headed by Rob Valentine announced there would be a Parliamentary Inquiry conducted into Tasmania's hospital resourcing as a result of increasing levels of concern being voiced by those working in, and engaged with, public acute health services, with the view to improving patient outcomes.

AMA Tasmania welcomed this news and had to date prepared and submitted two submissions to the inquiry - Mental Health and Child and Adolescent Mental Health and is in the process of completing the third submission for presentation to the committee on Monday.
